

FAQ - What is the concentration of antigen specific IgGs in polyclonal antiserum?

 $IgG\ polyclonal\ serum\ contains\ other\ proteins\ such\ as\ albumin\ and\ additional\ immunoglobulins\ which\ interfere\ with\ protein\ quantification.$ Consequently, only a minor part of the total IgG fraction is specific for the immunized antigen. A major part is directed against other unrelated antigens. Therefore, the exact concentration of antigen specific antibodies in polyclonal serum is unknown.
